In honor of National Homeownership Month, USDA Rural Development would like to recognize Antigo Housing Authority and their commitment to providing quality affordable housing to rural Wisconsin residents.



Dodge County Housing Authority (DCHA) is an active partner in preserving affordable housing in Rural Wisconsin. DCHA was able to obtain the financing for the acquisition and rehabilitation of a 24 unit family complex in Horicon, WI. Funding was provided by Wisconsin Housing and Economic Development Authority (WHEDA) Tax Credits and the use of the USDA Rural Development & Wisconsin Housing and WHEDA Preservation Revolving Loan Fund (PRLF).

The improvements included conversion of unit sizes, geothermal heating, replacement of windows, cabinets, carpeting, appliances, parking areas, walkways, ensuring ADA compliance, and much more.

The rehabilitation project utilized over \$3,000,000 of WHEDA Tax Credits and \$312,927 of WHEDA PRLF funds.
